

- Apply SUPRA SDRM® and cover with non-adherent mesh dressing; apply outer dressings for desired drainage management to maintain a moist wound healing environment.
- Outer dressings may be changed if soiled.

Debride devitalized tissue and refresh the wound with cross hatching as needed. Bring to hemostasis.

Apply **SUPRA SDRM®** to cover wound surface.

Non-adherent separation layer



Apply non-adherent dressing to keep **SUPRA SDRM®** in place. Apply outer dressings for desired drainage management. **SUPRA SDRM®** may be reapplied as required until wound healing is achieved.
